Verbs followed only by the gerund:

admit	like
avoid	love
deny	mind
dislike	miss practise
enjoy	prefer
feel like	recommend
finish	spend time
hate	stop
keep	suggest

Verbs followed only by the to infinitive:

(can't) afford	need
agree	pretend
decide	promise
expect	refuse
forget	remember
help	seem
hope	try
learn	want
	would like

Verbs that can be followed by the gerund or the infinitive with no difference in meaning

start begin continue

Verbs that can be followed by the gerund or the infinitive with a difference in meaning

stop try remember forget
