

Normal vs Advanced English

Examples Sentences

Meet vs Catch up

- Normal: Let's meet today.
- Advanced: Let's catch up today.

Help vs Assist

- Normal: Can you help me?
- Advanced: Can you assist me?

Talk vs Discuss

- Normal: Let's talk about it.
- Advanced: Let's discuss it.

Think vs Consider

- Normal: I think it's a good idea.
- Advanced: I consider it a good idea.

Start vs Commence

- Normal: Let's start the meeting.
- Advanced: Let's commence the meeting.

Get vs Receive

- Normal: I got your message.
- Advanced: I received your message.



Normal English vs Advanced English Examples

Need vs Require

- Normal: I need some help.
- Advanced: I require some assistance.

End vs Conclude

- Normal: Let's end the session.
- Advanced: Let's conclude the session.

Ask vs Inquire

- Normal: I asked about the problem.
- Advanced: I inquired about the issue.

Fix vs Repair

- Normal: I will fix the car.
- Advanced: I will repair the car.

Tell vs Inform

- Normal: Please tell me the details.
- Advanced: Please inform me of the details.

Try vs Attempt

- Normal: I will try to solve it.
- Advanced: I will attempt to solve it.

Buy vs Purchase

- Normal: I need to buy a new phone.
- Advanced: I need to purchase a new phone.

See vs Observe

- Normal: Did you see what happened?
- Advanced: Did you observe what happened?

Find out vs Discover

- Normal: I found out the truth.
- Advanced: I discovered the truth.

Call vs Contact

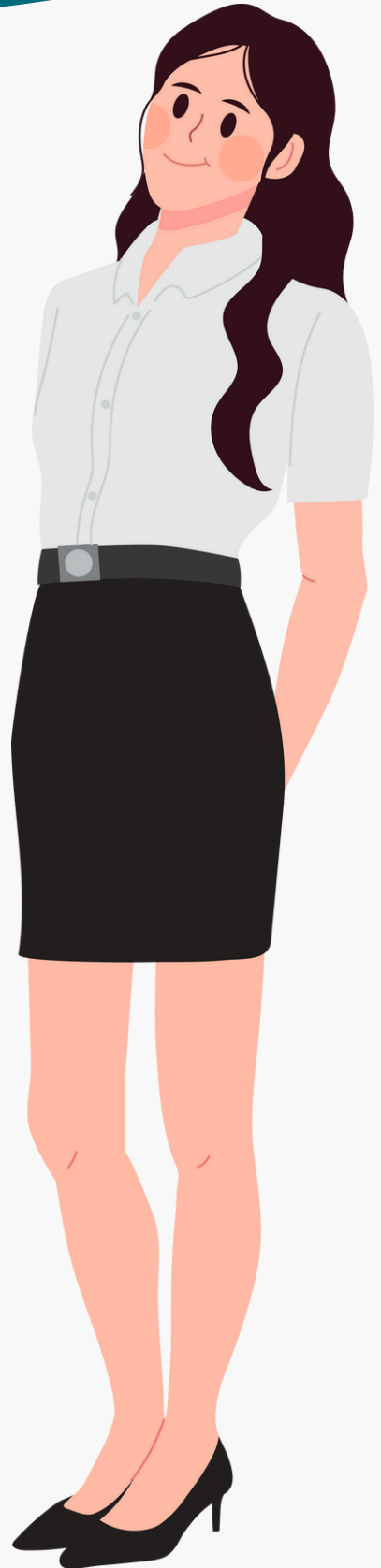
- Normal: I'll call you later.
- Advanced: I'll contact you later.

Deal with vs Handle

- Normal: I can deal with this issue.
- Advanced: I can handle this issue.

Say sorry vs Apologize

- Normal: I'm sorry for the mistake.
- Advanced: I apologize for the mistake.

Tell me vs Inform me

- Normal: Please tell me what happened.
- Advanced: Please inform me of what happened.

Look into vs Investigate

- Normal: I'll look into the matter.
- Advanced: I'll investigate the matter.

Check vs Verify

- Normal: Can you check the details?
- Advanced: Can you verify the details?

Live vs Reside

- Normal: I live in the city.
- Advanced: I reside in the city.

Start again vs Resume

- Normal: Let's start again.
- Advanced: Let's resume.

Ask for vs Request

- Normal: I asked for help.
- Advanced: I requested assistance.

Think about vs Contemplate

- Normal: I'm thinking about the issue.
- Advanced: I'm contemplating the issue.

Give up vs Surrender

- Normal: They gave up quickly.
- Advanced: They surrendered quickly.

Look at vs Examine

- Normal: I'll look at the report.
- Advanced: I'll examine the report.

Go vs Depart

- Normal: I need to go now.
- Advanced: I need to depart now.

Help out vs Assist

- Normal: Can you help me out?
- Advanced: Can you assist me?

Talk to vs Speak with

- Normal: I need to talk to you.
- Advanced: I need to speak with you.

Find vs Locate

- Normal: I need to find my keys.
- Advanced: I need to locate my keys.

Get ready vs Prepare

- Normal: I need to get ready.
- Advanced: I need to prepare.

Stop vs Cease

- Normal: They stopped working.
- Advanced: They ceased working.

Make sure vs Ensure

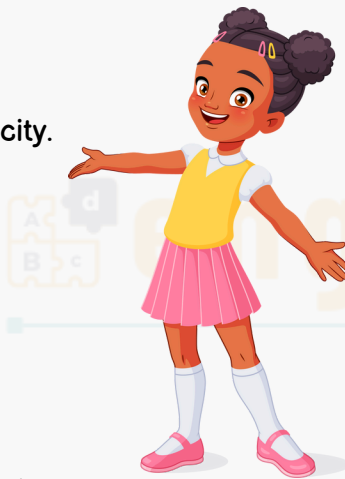
- Normal: Make sure you have everything.
- Advanced: Ensure you have everything.

Let vs Permit

- Normal: Please let me know.
- Advanced: Please permit me to know.

Begin vs Initiate

- Normal: Let's begin the process.
- Advanced: Let's initiate the process.



Normal vs Advanced English Examples

Leave vs Vacate

- Normal: Please leave the room.
- Advanced: Please vacate the room.

Eat vs Consume

- Normal: I want to eat something.
- Advanced: I want to consume something.

Tell off vs Reprimand

- Normal: The boss told him off.
- Advanced: The boss reprimanded him.

Take care of vs Oversee

- Normal: I'll take care of the project.
- Advanced: I'll oversee the project.

Give up vs Relinquish

- Normal: She gave up her position.
- Advanced: She relinquished her position.

Start over vs Restart

- Normal: We need to start over.
- Advanced: We need to restart.

Speed up vs Accelerate

- Normal: Can you speed up the process?
- Advanced: Can you accelerate the process?

Run out of vs Deplete

- Normal: We've run out of supplies.
- Advanced: We've depleted our supplies.

Keep on vs Continue

- Normal: Keep on working hard.
- Advanced: Continue working hard.

Get on vs Board

- Normal: Let's get on the train.
- Advanced: Let's board the train.

Put off vs Postpone

- Normal: They put off the meeting.
- Advanced: They postponed the meeting.

Talk over vs Negotiate

- Normal: We need to talk over the deal.
- Advanced: We need to negotiate the deal.

Look for vs Seek

- Normal: I'm looking for a job.
- Advanced: I'm seeking a job.

Look after vs Take care of

- Normal: I'll look after the kids.
- Advanced: I'll take care of the kids.

Keep vs Retain

- Normal: I'll keep this document.
- Advanced: I'll retain this document.

Go back vs Return

- Normal: Let's go back home.
- Advanced: Let's return home.

Cut down vs Reduce

- Normal: I need to cut down expenses.
- Advanced: I need to reduce expenses.

Give back vs Return

- Normal: Please give back my book.
- Advanced: Please return my book.
